The Call to Order was made and the Pledge to the Flag was completed.

<u>ANNOUNCEMENT</u> - An executive session was held on September 29, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. to discuss personnel issues. In attendance were Supervisors Bruce Light, Richard Rudy (via telephone) and Michael Saphore, Township Solicitor Andrew Morrow and Township Manager Melissa Johnson.

Michael Saphore made a motion to appoint Clark Hill to serve as the Township Labor & Employment Law Attorney retroactive to September 23, 2025. Seconded by Bruce Light. All voted in favor.
